Images should be sized at 1600 x 1200 dpi maximum\*; JPGs format; and preferably in sRGB colour space.

## CHALLENGE - the 26 titles for the 2024 -2025 season

It is not a competition just a bit of fun. Lets see how many different images of the subjects can be found by us all. All must start with a letter of the alphabet from A to M and then N to Z

Please **number** your files with the above number <u>first</u>, **then** your title and **then** your name. EG. **01-Ostrich-Magor-D**.jpg

Then we can show all the images from the same subject together.

NOTE\* **Image sizing** – the maximum image size is  $1600 \times 1200$  pixels (which is a  $4 \times 3$  ratio). This means your supplied image must not be wider than 1600 px nor higher than 1200 px.

If you image does not 'suit' this aspect ratio (say it looks better as a letterbox shape) then its maximum width allowed remains 1600px, but it's height can be anything BELOW 1200px.

If the image is portrait format (upright) it's maximum height must be 1200px. Then it's width must be somewhat less than 1200px.

Also bear in mind images supplied at rather less than above sizes will not show as well as correctly sized images. So it is important to 'manage' image sizing. This is even more important for the 'formal' competitions on Fridays, at HPS or if you wish to enter external competitions (where you can be rejected if the sizes are not correct).
